


KELSO'S CHOICE WHEEL

Read to Rover Permission Slip

“Read to Rover” is a wonderful program that allows 2nd grade students to read with a volunteer “team” that includes a dog and its owner in our school library. This year, every 2nd grader will be given this opportunity. Participation is not required, however, and if your child chooses not to participate, that is fine. Students who do choose to participate will “Read to Rover” once every 3 week on Monday for a 20 minute period of time. The program will continue for the rest of the year.

The following will be the rules:

1. The children should let the owner introduce them to the dog.
2. They need to be very gentle and calm with the dogs.
3. Remember personal space (even dogs like personal space!)
4. The owner might allow them to give a treat to the dog at the end of the session. Not all dogs will be given treats though. Some are on special diets.
5. Some of the kids might not know a lot about dogs. That's OK. These dogs are very gentle and have gone through special training screening.
6. If someone DOESN'T want to participate in the program, it's OK. You don't have to.
7. Participating is a privilege. We must be able to trust that you will be safe around the dogs.
8. You may not get the dog that you want. Be flexible. It will hurt the owner's feelings if you say, "I don't want to read to that dog". The volunteer will tell you which dog you read to and you will say "OK"!
9. Kids need to bring their own book box.

Please go over these rules with your child so that they understand what is expected.
