Parents and Families are invited to join the fun of Market. Parent and Family shopping will begin at 10:00am in the OPEPO Classroom.

All students are asked to participate as a vendor during Market. We suspend normal class activities to do this fun event and it is important that families help their student to participate as a buyer and seller. We use OPEPO dollars (not real money) to simulate a real-world market. Planning, preparing, and running their "business" provides rich, real-world connections that deepen the math content we are learning in class. Market plans are due on or before Monday, December 2nd.

***In order to make this a kid-friendly learning experience, we ask parents/families to:*

-Please support the learning/enrichment of Market at home by working with your child to plan/create their business experience.

-Only buy a few items from students with "hot commodity" items, and please DO NOT 'buy-out' someone's stall.

-Support all students by noticing who may not be selling much and buy from them so that their business feels valued and engaged in the process.

-Lean in and help students "do the math" as they sell their items.

-Closely supervise young children/siblings during Market

MARKET GUIDELINES:

- Your market stall may include: handmade products, services, healthy homemade food items, resale items (gently-used treasures), games (with prizes), or raffles.
- Food items/treats must be made by YOU, the seller. Please remember we are encourage HEALTHY options during Market. Food items must have ingredient lists at the Market stall, signed by a parent. If you have any concerns about food allergies/ food for sale, please let your child and the teachers know how to proceed when your child decides what to buy.
- Students may have a raffle. Raffles will be limited to the first 5 raffle plans turned in, so be sure to have a "Plan B."
- Students should make an artistic/creative store sign (e.g. Buddy's Bizarre Bazaar) with a list of prices of products/services, or individually price items.
- Make an open/closed sign so that you may leave your store to go shopping, or drape a piece of cloth over your stall when shopping. Parents/adults may not take over selling while a student is away from their stall.
- As you make your plan, consider what sold well last time and at what prices. You may ask around to find out what others are interested in buying before you finalize your plan (due Mon. December 2nd). If you are new to OPEPO, please feel free to contact your buddy family to ask questions or check in with Heather.

WHAT WE WILL WORK ON IN MATH:

- We will work with whole OPEPO (fake money) dollar amounts, no coins.
- Students who were in OPEPO last year will begin the year with the money they have deposited in their accounts. Students who are new to OPEPO will be loaned \$25.00 to start their accounts.
- All vendors need to start their Market day knowing how much they spent on material, so they can budget how much they have to spend, as these costs will be deducted from their accounts at the end of Market.
- All vendors will rent their stall for \$10
- Rent will be paid after Market Day
- Students are expected to tally or keep an inventory sheet of the number of items sold.
- Students will complete an "end of Market" sales/budget report during "settle-up time," or the next Math class.5 1
